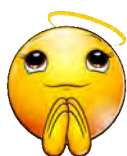

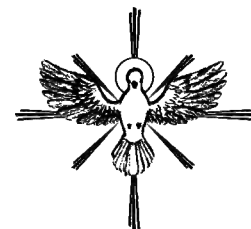

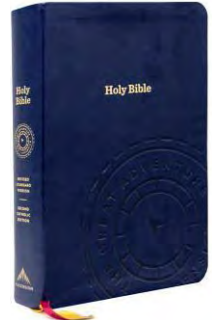
Overview of the Organization
