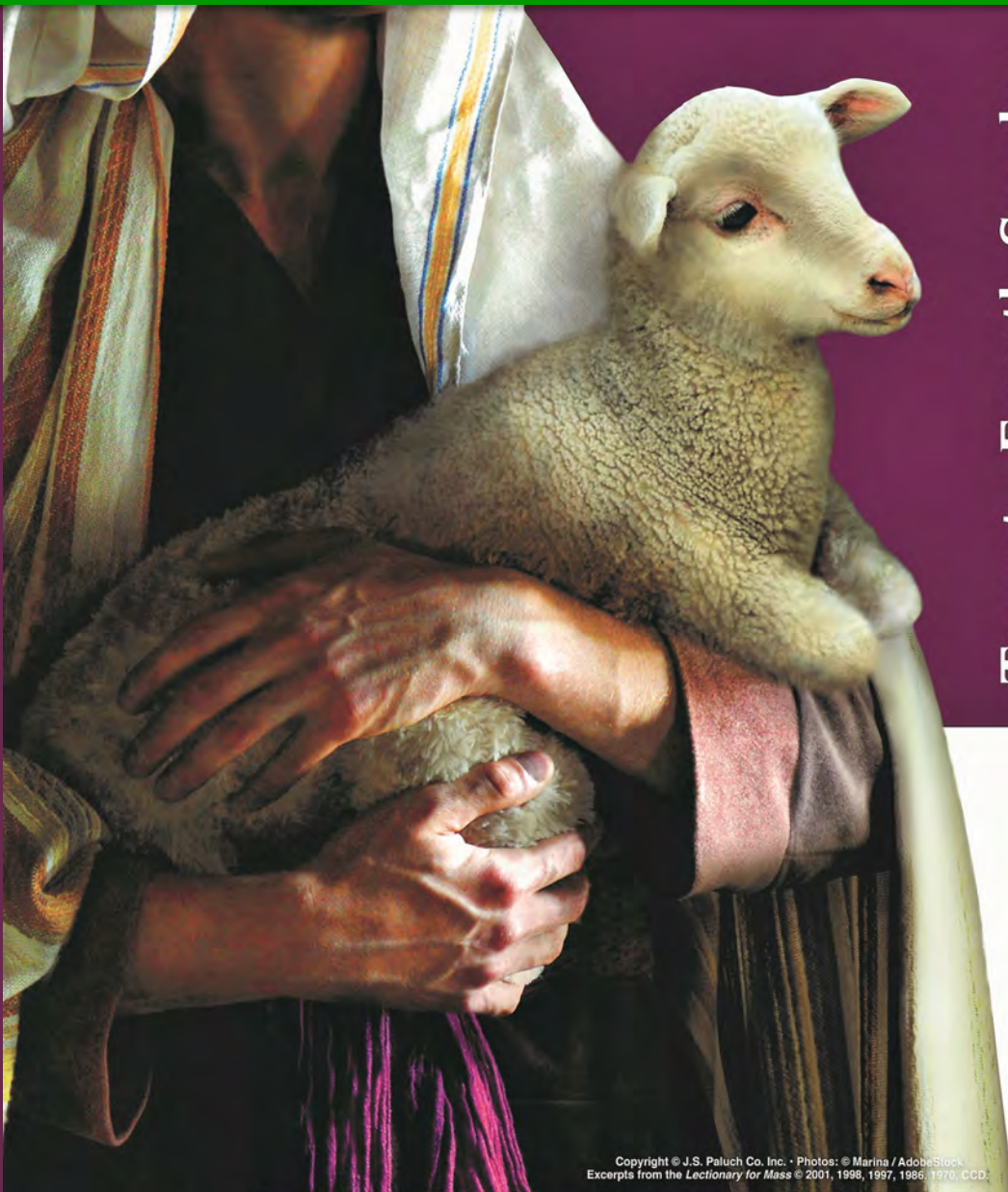

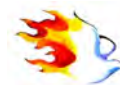

## Corpus Christi Council of Catholic Women (CCW) Corner

Kathy Jalove, long time CCW member and Woman of the Year in 1996 was CCW's guest who lead the Opening Prayer at its last meeting on September 2. Kathy shared stories about family life, especially as a wife of Deacon Andrew, her spiritual growth due to her love for Church, her children, and how she cherishes traditional holiday traditions.



CCW has three major functions: **Service, Leadership, and Spirituality**. Because any lady registered in our parish automatically is a CCW member, when she comes to the monthly meetings she is invited to sit and join the committee where she feels she can contribute best. Each committee is not a separate body but each support and complement the other committees so all CCW projects blend into one. Hence, all members are expected to help and be present to all CCW events.

1. **Service Committee** plans humanitarian and community needs service projects, such as collecting and coordinating food donations, school supplies for needy children, items to help senior folks, etc. This committee works closely with St. Vincent de Paul, DuPage Social Services and Carol Stream Humanitarian Service Office.
2. **The Leadership Committee** members think of many creative ways to raise money to support all CCW projects, and promote social, educational development of all members and especially how to support the Religious and Church needs of our Parish. Bake Sales, Raffle Ticket sales, asking for help from the local restaurants to donate part of their tax proceeds, fall in this category.
3. To be close to God is the main goal of all CCW Women. Thus, the **Spiritual Committee** think of ways to increase the spiritual growth of the women by holding pilgrimage tours, events such as Festival of Saints, Rosary Prayers, inviting speakers to talk on topics important to every Catholic, hosting ice cream socials and parish hospitality.

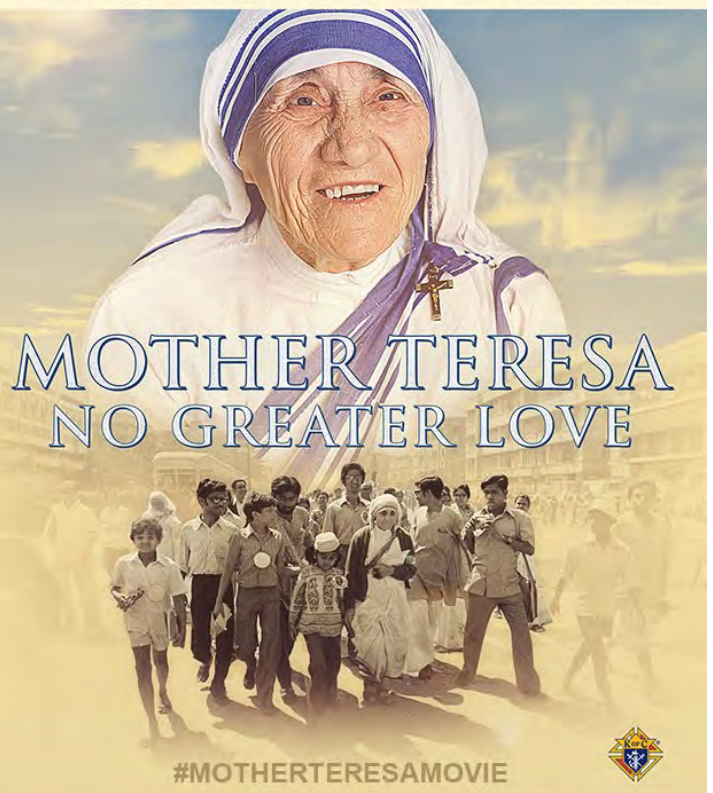
