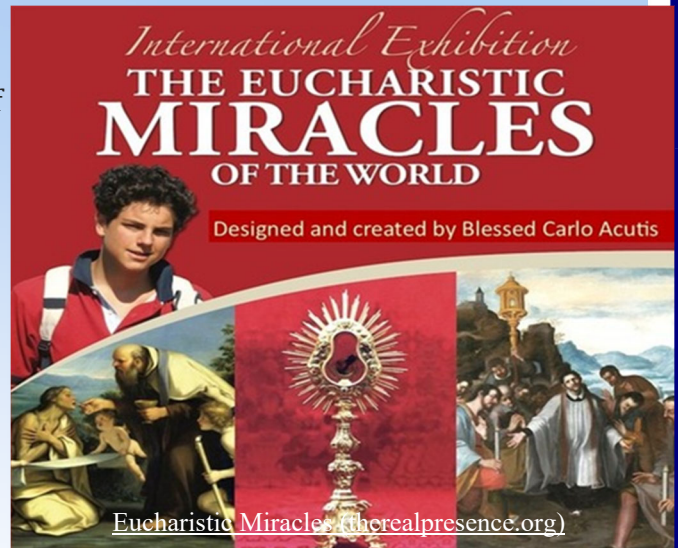


Vatican Eucharistic Miracles Exhibition

In the entire history of the Catholic Church, there have been numerous Eucharistic miracles approved by the Catholic Church as truly worthy of belief. The Vatican Eucharistic Miracles Exhibition faithfully recounts for us many well documented miraculous occurrences. Knowledge of these miracles strengthens our faith in Christ and His Church. They are visible proof of Jesus Christ's Real Presence in the Holy Eucharist. The Exhibit was created by Blessed Carlo Acutis, a 15 year old from Milan, Italy who was beatified on October 10, 2020.

The Exhibit will be available for viewing at our parish December 3 - 12 in Marian Hall. We highly encourage you to view

the exhibit at our parish during this time of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' three-year National Eucharistic Revival.



Eucharistic Miracles are extraordinary events where the Eucharist no longer appears under the form of bread and wine, but takes on the biological qualities of human flesh or blood or both. The original gathering of these miracles was done by Blessed Carlo Acutis in the early 2000s before his death from leukemia in 2006. Our parish will be one of the few locations in the Chicago area hosting these displays.

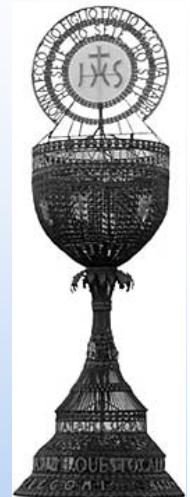

Blessing of an Advent Wreath

(Adapted from *Magnificat*)

The use of the Advent Wreath is a traditional practice which has found its place in the Church as well as in the home. The blessing of an Advent Wreath takes place on the First Sunday of Advent or on the evening before the First Sunday of Advent or on the evening before the First Sunday of Advent.

Customarily the Advent Wreath is constructed of a circle of evergreen branches into which are inserted four candles. According to Tradition, three candles are violet and the fourth is rose. However, four violet or white candles may be used.

The candles represent the four weeks of Advent, and the number of candles lighted each week corresponds to the number of the current week of Advent. The rose candle is lighted on the Third Sunday of Advent, also known as Gaudete (Rejoice) Sunday.

When the blessing of the Advent Wreath is celebrated in the home, it is appropriate that it be blessed by a parent or another member of the family. All make the sign of the cross.

The leader says:

Lord our God, We praise you for your Son, Jesus Christ: He is Emmanuel, the hope of the peoples, He is the wisdom that teaches and guides us, He is the Savior of every nation.

Lord God, Let your blessing come upon us As we light the candles of this wreath. May the wreath and its light Be a sign of Christ's promise to bring us salvation. May he come quickly and not delay. We ask this through Christ our Lord.



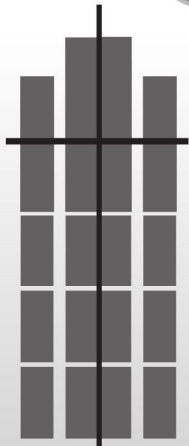
THANK YOU!!
