## Learning about Mary's Titles with the Legion of Mary

### Our Lady Refuge of sinners



***Our Lady, Refuge of Sinners/Refugium Peccatorum:*** St John Damascene calls Mary a city of refuge to all who flee to Her. This idea of a city of refuge is an old Scriptural fact calling attention to the humanity, the pity, of the old Jewish Law, which established certain cities of refuge where criminals might find escape from the arm of the authorities. For instance there were no less than six Levitical Cities, three on either side of the Jordan, where men who had been guilty of the act of involuntary homicide might find protection and immunity, until they were released from banishment by the death of the High Priest. These six cities were obliged to receive the homicides and to lodge them without any charge. The Jewish idea was brought into Christianity. One of the beautiful customs in the Middle Ages was "the right of sanctuary," by which those who ran afoul of the law could not be taken so long as they remained in the Church, or sanctuary. **And this is Our Lady, Refuge of Sinners!**

The Jewish idea As the Refuge of Sinners, Mary is a resting place for us in the moments when we feel too ashamed or weighed down by our sins and failings to come directly before Our Heavenly Father. Our Lady loves you and wants to wrap you in her mantle of motherly love, to hold you closely and securely in the midst of the storm. Like we confidently proclaim in the Memorare: it was never known that anyone who fled to her was left unaided.

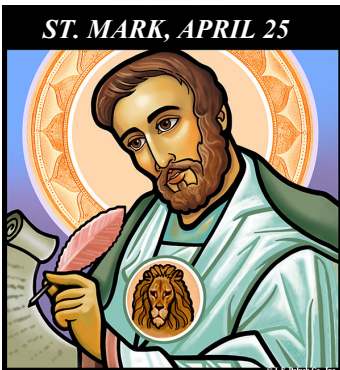

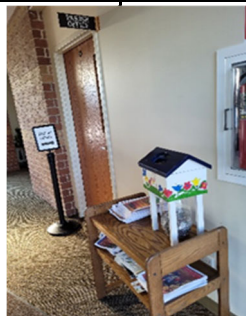
was a Christian with spiritual and intellectual depth, a priestly heart, and a desire to glorify the Lord. A truly superb biography of a truly outstanding man of God.
