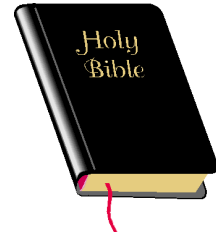
## Confirmation Requirements for 2023-24

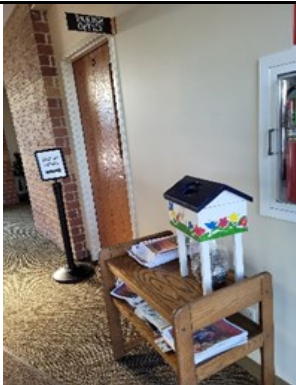

## Learning about Mary's Titles with the Legion of Mary

### *Mary Star of the Sea*



In Wikipedia, Stella Maris (Nostre) or Our Lady, Star of the Sea, was **used to emphasize Mary's role as a guiding star for Christians**. Writings from the 9th century said that Mary, Star of the Sea, was a “guide” to be followed on the way to Christ to avoid capsizing in storm-tossed waters.

The *Catholic Encyclopedia* mentions that this title of Mary originated from St. Jerome's fifth century translation of Eusebius of Caesarea's *Onomasticon* (dictionary of proper names) in which he translates Mary's name in Hebrew—*Miryam*, meaning drop of the sea—into the Latin *Stilla Maris*, which later became *Stella Maris* due to a dialect of the Latin peasants.

Our Lady who points us in the direction of Her Son, helping us navigate the sometimes-rough waters of this world and even our own passions. A drop in the ocean becomes the guide for the entire sea; an unknown girl through faith and generosity becoming the Mother of God. The title now also evoked to me God's exaltation of humility.

Saint Bernard of Clairvaux 12<sup>th</sup> century wrote :

*If the winds of temptation arise; If you are driven upon the rocks of tribulation look to the star, call on Mary; If you are tossed upon the waves of pride, of ambition, of envy, of rivalry, look to the star, call on Mary. Should anger, or avarice, or fleshly desire violently assail the frail vessel of your soul, look at the star, call upon Mary.*

The Feast Day of Mary Star of the Sea is celebrated on 31 May.
