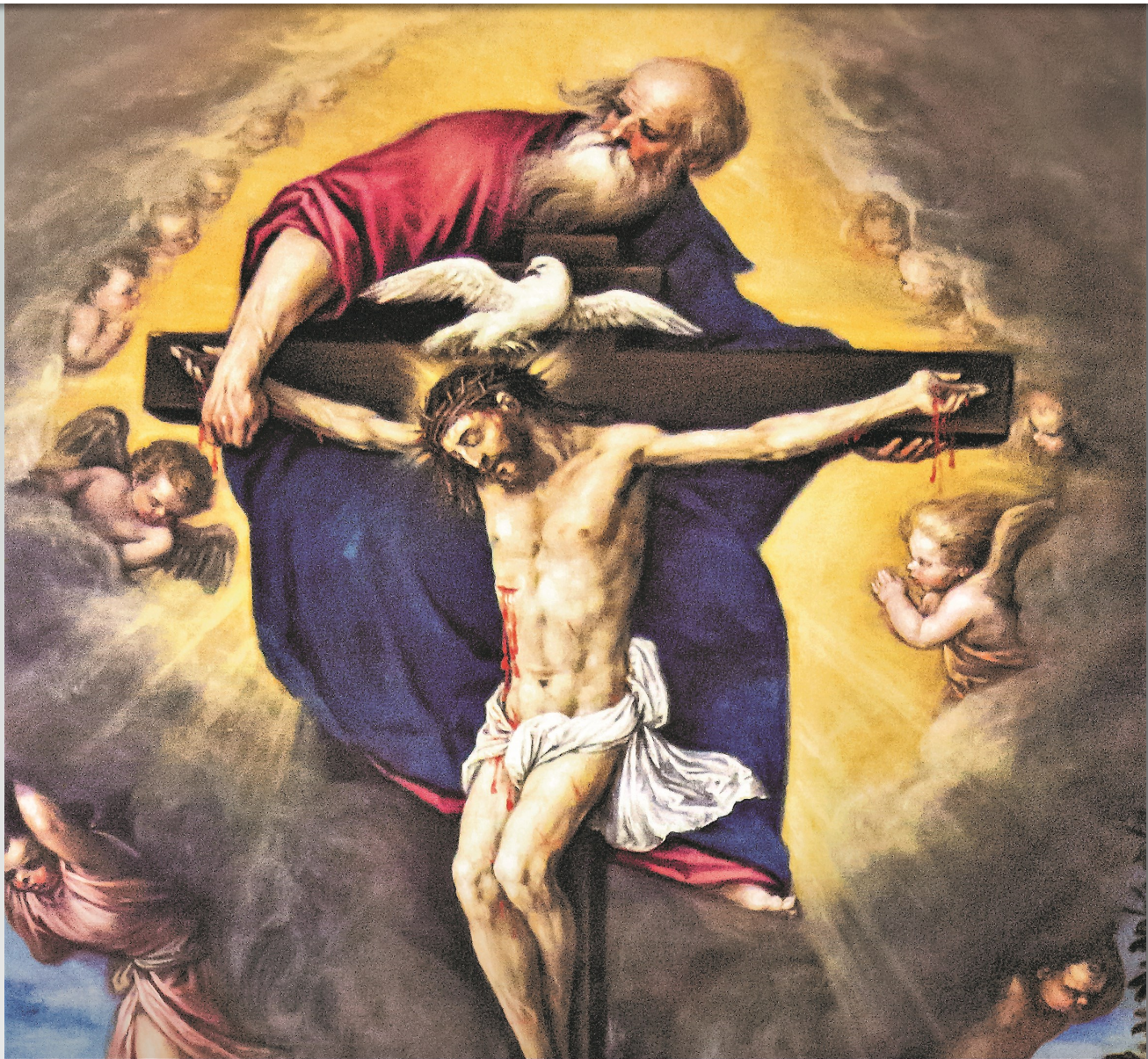

- 12:15 pm – **Picnic and Taste of Corpus Christi** (in gardens)

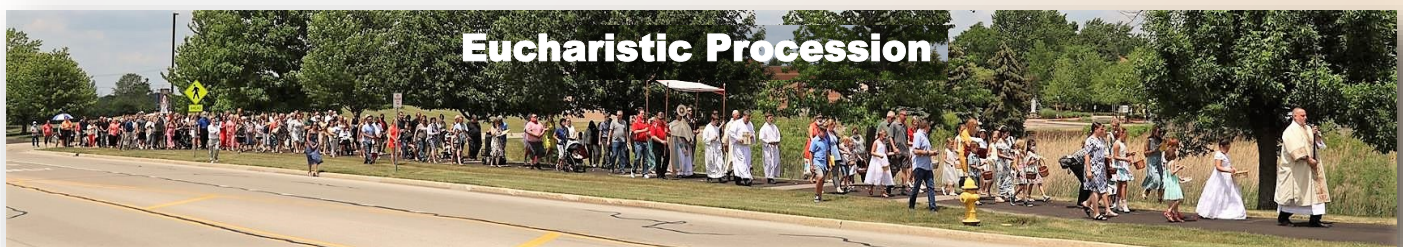

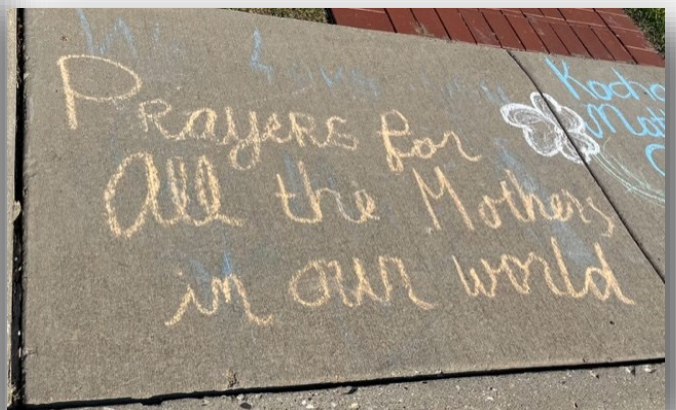

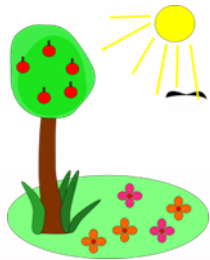

Confirmation Requirements for 2023-24

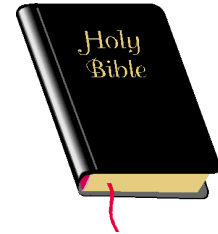
All students entering Confirmation I or Confirmation II in the Fall will have the following requirements:

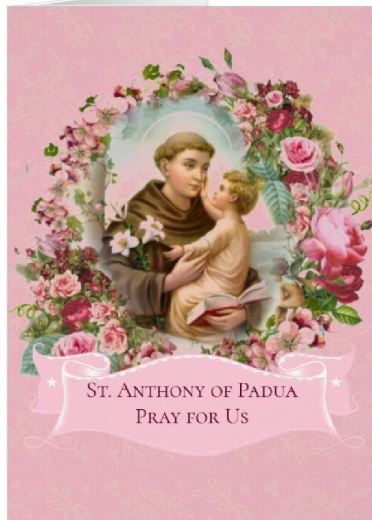
