## Celebrating the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

The Eucharist is “the source and summit of the Christian life” – as we read in the Catechism of the Catholic Church, Paragraph No 1324. This is not an exaggeration. Jesus ascended into heaven but is present in His Church in the Eucharist. In the church we bow down in front of the altar which symbolizes Jesus, but we genuflect or kneel in front of the Body of Christ (in Latin Corpus Christi). The highest act of worshipping God is when we celebrate the Eucharist (the summit), and the highest possible connection with Jesus is when we receive His Body in the Eucharist (the source). The Eucharist helps us to live in a Christian way on earth and protects us in our struggles with our weaknesses and attacks of the Evil One.

Last year, the Church in the United States began the National Eucharistic Revival which is a movement to restore understanding and devotion to the great mystery of the Eucharist by helping us renew our worship of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. The culminating point of this revival will be the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis in July 2024.

Both the Eucharistic Revival and the Eucharistic Congress create an extraordinary opportunity for the American Church and particular dioceses, parishes, religious congregations, various organizations, movements, and groups to affirm the Eucharist as the source and summit of their activities and of the Christian life.

The Feast of Corpus Christi is a special feast for our parish which carries this special name. Every year after the main Mass at 10 am, we hold a special Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession to four altar stations

prepared in our parking lot and along Lies Road. In this procession, we give a public manifestation of our faith. It is true that faith is something private and intimate but, at the same time, it is public and should be shared with others. The Eucharistic Jesus traveling on our streets during this procession blesses all people living in Carol Stream and neighboring towns.

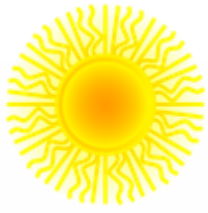
Join us on Sunday, June 11 at the bilingual 10 am Mass for this Corpus Christi celebration, followed by the procession and picnic in our parish gardens. Everyone in the state of grace on this day (no mortal sin and rejecting venial sins), receiving Holy Communion and praying for the intention of the Holy Father, can attain a plenary indulgence.

All students entering Confirmation I or Confirmation II in the Fall will have the following requirements:

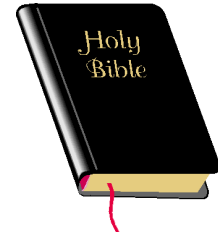
- ✠ Attend fifteen (15) Masses and complete fifteen (15) Mass Reflection sheets (available outside the Youth Ministry office and in the narthex).

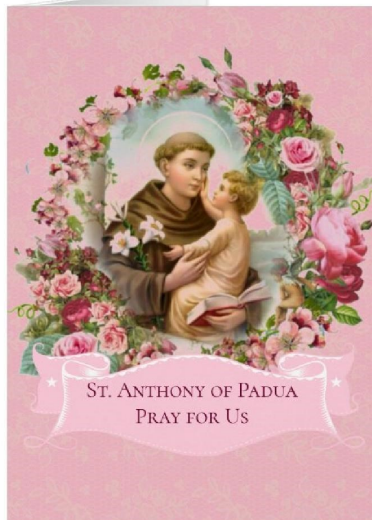

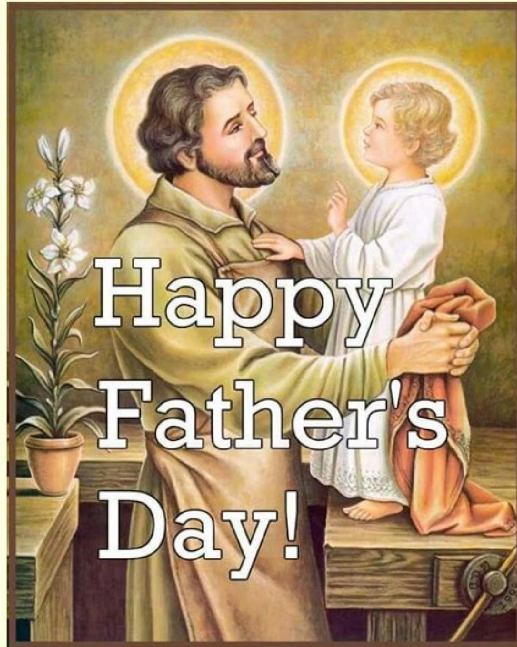

## Learning about Mary's Titles with the Legion of Mary

# Who is Our Lady of Perpetual Help?

Our Mother of Perpetual Help (Succor) or **Our Lady of Perpetual Help** is a title given to the Blessed Virgin Mary, associated with the Byzantine icon of the same name, said to be from the 13th or 14th century, but perhaps 15th century, which has been in Rome since at least the late 15th century. The image is very popular among Catholics throughout the world and has been much copied and reproduced. In the Byzantine Church this iconography is known as the Theotokos of the Passion.

The icon depicts the Blessed Virgin Mary wearing a dress of dark red with blue mantle and veil. On the left is the archangel Michael, carrying the lance and sponge as instruments of Jesus Christ's crucifixion. On the right is the archangel Gabriel carrying a 3-bar cross and nails. Mary is pointing to her Son, known as a Theotokos of the Passion. The Christ-child has been alarmed by a pre-sentiment of his Passion and has run to his mother for comfort. The facial expression of the Virgin Mary is solemn and is looking directly at the viewer instead of her son. Jesus is portrayed clinging to his mother with a dangling sandal. The icon is painted with a gold background.

### Prayer to Our Mother of Perpetual Help



*O Mother of Perpetual Help! With the greatest of confidence I approach you to implore your aid. You have seen the wounds of your Son and His blood shed for our salvation. You know how He desires our salvation. Because of this, I kneel before you and beseech you to obtain for me the mercy of which I stand in such great need. O Mary, most amiable among women, obtain the favor I seek from Jesus, the source of all good. Here, state intention. O Mother of Perpetual Help, you desire our salvation more than we ourselves do. Your Son has given you to be our mother, and you have chosen for yourself the name: Mother of Perpetual Help. I do not trust in my own merits, but in your powerful intercession. I trust in your goodness and in your motherly love. For the love that you have for Jesus, your Son, and my Savior, for the love of the souls faithful to you, and for the sake of your love for my soul, obtain for me all the graces and favors I ask of you. Amen.*
