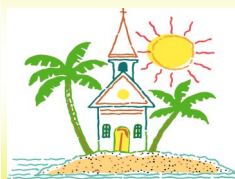

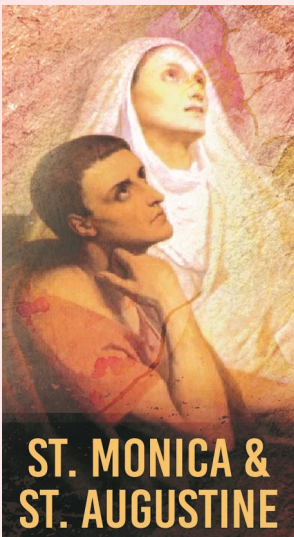

I am an Albertine Sister and I fulfil our calling on missions in Bolivia by serving people being the most in need of support at the St. John Paul II Centre in Cochabamba.

The objective of the Centre is to bring aid to mothers who carry a conceived life and have found themselves in a difficult situation.

The solitude of pregnant women and mothers raising children is commonplace in Bolivia and stems from the so-called "Machismo". It surprises no one when a father abandons his family, leaving the responsibility of caring for the children and providing for the household to the woman. According to statistics, Bolivia is ranked high amongst locations where "being a mother is difficult".

It is all the "more difficult to be a mother" when a pregnant woman is left alone with several children.

In Bolivia, motherhood is experienced early. Bolivia has one of the highest teenage pregnancy rates in the world. Then, they leave their home and look for help outside so as not to burden their parents and siblings.



We cannot ignore the fact that for a young girl or a mother of several children, giving birth to a child is an act of true heroism because they lack appropriate means or the support of their family and because abortion is promoted as a "good solution".

Therefore, we must do everything in our power (as St. John Paul II exhorted) so that "abortion becomes unthinkable", so that no Mother is left alone with her struggles. Spiritual, moral and material support is necessary.

Every mother is provided by us with food products, a layette, a cardboard cradle, diapers, milk (if needed), and even a accommodation.

By offering such simple aid, we protect the lives of unborn children so that each of them can be welcomed and surrounded by love.
