Dear Brothers and Sisters,

1. On November 1, we commemorate All Saints Day - all good people who in an extraordinary way fulfilled the precepts of the Gospel. They are in Heaven with God, the angels, and "*a great multitude, which no one could count, from every nation, race, people, and tongue*" who stand "*before the throne and before the Lamb, wearing white robes and holding palm branches in their hands.*" (Revelation 7:9). They are praying for us and cheering us on to eternal happiness; they are our supporters who wish that all people be with them and God in Heaven.



2. The following day, November 2 – All Souls Day - we pray in a special way for our departed brothers and sisters. The Church believes that our prayers can support those who, although saved, still have to purify themselves in Purgatory in order to stand holy and blameless before God in Heaven. The Church encourages us to pray for them and, if possible, to visit their graves, especially in the Octave of All Saints Day, from November 1 - 8. We can visit a cemetery and pray for the deceased, even if no one from our families or friends is buried there. Prayer for those who passed away, especially for those we do not know, is a powerful act of Christian charity. Let us continue to pray for the Holy Souls in Purgatory, especially throughout the month of November – the month of all Holy Souls.


Memorial Bench for Mark Herwaldt


