### **Jubilee Year of Hope 2025**

Bishop Ronald A. Hicks has designated Corpus Christi Catholic Church to be a place of pilgrimage.

Beginning Sunday, February 2 and every Sunday from 3 to 4 pm, there will be a Holy Hour with the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament.

Confession will be available from 3 to 3:30 pm.

Beginning Thursday, February 6 and every Thursday, Mass will be celebrated at 6 pm. Confession and Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will precede the Mass at 5:30 pm.

There will be no 9 am Mass on Thursdays.

#### **Candlemas**

Next weekend, as we celebrate the Presentation of the Lord, we will offer a blessing of candles at all weekend Masses. Bring your own candle or buy a Jubilee Year Candle in the narthex before all Masses for \$10. Proceeds from the sale of the Jubilee Year candles will go to the Holy Family Church in the Gaza Strip (the only Catholic church in Gaza, Palestine).

The Presentation of the Lord is a proclamation of Christ as Messiah and Priest, Lord and Savior. Jesus is the light who came into this world to dispel sin and darkness. For this reason, traditionally at least since the seventh century, candles have been blessed at Mass this day that will be used throughout the year. (Hence, the Mass for the Presentation of the Lord has traditionally been called "Candlemas.")



#### Feast of St. Blaise and Blessings of Throats Next Weekend



St. Blaise was a physician before he became a priest and then a bishop, and he was martyred in the fourth century. He once miraculously cured a boy on the verge of death with a bone stuck in his

throat. Candles are crossed in a special candelabrum used to bless throats. The blessing of the throats is a sacramental of the Roman Catholic Church, celebrated on February 3, the feast day of Saint Blaise asking for his aid in delivering the faithful from throat ailments and other evils.

There will be a general blessing of throats at all Masses February 1-2 in observance of the feast of St. Blaise.



### 8-Week Bible Study Program

By Bishop Robert Barron

Bishop Robert Barron presents on the seven deadly sins, those great spiritual blocks that inhibit our flourishing in relationship with God and one another. Based on Dante's





writings, the seven deadly sins correspond to the seven stories of Dante's Mt. Purgatory. Pride, envy, anger, sloth, gluttony, avarice and lust are all presented as patterns of dysfunction within us that lead to unhappiness.

Bishop Barron shows us how to counteract these seven sinful patterns through a conscious process of opposition, known as the "seven lively virtues." These offer antidotes to each sin and help set us on the right path to healing and happiness.


