#### The Pastor's Corner...

#### God's Graces Require Our Will, Action and Determination

The Jubilee Year is a special year of grace from God. Through a plenary indulgence, grace is granted by the Catholic Church through the merits of Jesus Christ to remove the temporal punishment due to sin. Although God's love and mercy towards us is bottomless, we must have a special disposition to receive His graces. God is not distributing His graces randomly or blindly. Just the opposite is true: He is very specific and not "wasting" His graces. He gives graces to a person who is able to receive them and can use them for good.

In the Jubilee Year, we are encouraged to deepen our faith. This does not come to us automatically – it requires our will, action, engagement and determination. We are called to reject anything that is sinful and open ourselves to what is good. As I mentioned a few weeks ago, obtaining a plenary indulgence – which is a special gift of the Jubilee Year – could seem very easy to receive but, in fact, not so easy as it looks at first glance. With the relatively easy part – visiting a pilgrimage church in Rome or any pilgrimage church like ours – a true conversion of the heart must be present. After our



sincere and strong effort to live in holiness, the graces of indulgence are given to us.

Today, I would like to mention another way to receive a plenary indulgence during the Jubilee Year: Acts in the spirit of penance. In fact, acts of penance could be a more demanding way of obtaining an indulgence than visiting a jubilee church, especially when this church is so close to us, like Corpus Christi. The Vatican decree enumerates several initiatives for the Jubilee Year through which we can obtain indulgences during this time:

- By **rediscovering** the penitential nature of Friday. This can be done by abstaining at least for one day of the week from **futile distractions**, real and also **virtual distractions**, for example, the use of the media and/or social networks), or abstaining from superfluous consumption, by **fasting** or practicing abstinence);
- by **donating** a proportionate sum of money to the poor;
- by supporting works of a religious or social nature especially by supporting the **defense and protection of life in all its phases**.
- by supporting the needy, lonely elderly people, abandoned children, young people in difficulty, or migrants;
- by dedicating a reasonable portion of one's **free time** to voluntary activities that are of service to the community or to other similar forms of personal commitment.

These practices are very concrete and could be practiced by everyone, young and old, even by children. We are called to practice them every day and year-round, but undertaking them in the Jubilee Year gives them special significance and meaning and also creates a base for obtaining Indulgence. They especially correspond to the atmosphere of Lent which we entered into this past Wednesday. I would like to encourage each and every one of you, and myself: Do not miss this extraordinary opportunity to go deeper in our Christian faith to discover the real and practical meaning of being Catholic.

#### LENTEN REGULATIONS

- 1. Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- 2. Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- 3. On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
- 4. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.
- 5. Lent is the principal season of penance in the Christian year. All of the faithful are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial (in addition to following the Lenten regulations), serious prayer, and a performance of works of charity and mercy.



Dear Parishioners of Corpus Christi Parish,

Phase 3 of the Targeted Restructuring process, which included parishes in DuPage, Will and Grundy counties, is now complete. The Diocesan Targeted Restructuring Committee began this third phase in April of 2024 and over the next eight months, the Committee engaged in an intentional process to determine the future of these parishes. On December 20th I received the Committee's recommendations. After much prayer and discernment, I have decided to accept the Committee's recommendations. On February 13, 2025, I consulted with our Presbyteral Council, in accord with Canon Law. The Presbyteral Council unanimously approved my acceptance of the restructuring recommendations for Phase 3.

Accordingly, I have rendered the following decision:

St. Luke in Carol Stream will amalgamate into Corpus Christi in Carol Stream. The church and buildings of St. Luke in Carol Stream will close.

These changes will go into effect as of July 1, 2025. There will be much information shared with your pastor and parish leadership regarding the next steps, and the support that will be provided by the Diocese. I encourage you to read all the information concerning the restructuring process and decisions on the Diocesan website. You will find on the website my official decision, a video about the process and answers to a number of frequently asked questions, including the definition of church terms that we use in these decisions.

I want you to know I have listened to you. I have heard and read your concerns and reservations. I have humbly witnessed your faith devotion, your personal sacrifices and your parish commitment. Be assured the Targeted Restructuring Committee and I considered with respect your input, insights and suggestions. And while I am confident these decisions are the right ones for the future of the Church, I understand these results are very difficult when they directly affect you and your family. Change is hard. The changes may affect where you worship, how far you need to drive to attend mass or participate in parish events, and what you consider to be your intimate faith community. I appreciate these decisions may cause you to be sad and lead to a time of grieving.

During the parish sessions last year, the following scripture was shared, which I hope provides you solace:

"Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God; have faith also in me. In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back again and take you to myself, so that where I am you also may be. Where I am going you know the way." (John 14:1-7)

Thank you for your love of Jesus Christ and your commitment to His Church. With great faith and hope, let us ask the Holy Spirt to bless, lead, and guide us in these next steps within the Diocese of Joliet. May God bless you today and always.




