



Requirements for all Confirmation I and II Students

All Confirmation I and II students MUST attend a minimum of fifteen (15) Masses per year and write a 3-4 sentence reflection on the homily. Mass Attendance must be in person and reflections must be submitted online. Students must also complete ten (10) hours of service and submit a Service Project form for each project.

All requirements MUST BE COMPLETED prior to the start of the new Faith Formation year.

This movie explores the life of soon-to-be young Saint Carlo Acutis and his approach to the modern digital world. It also follows high school students on a pilgrimage to Italy, encouraging them to disconnect from technology and reflect on Carlo's impact. "One of the themes in the film is that Carlo was online to lead people offline. He was online to lead people back to the Eucharist, back to real encounters," Tim Moriarty, director of the new Acutis film.

Who was Carlo Acutis? Blessed Carlo Acutis will become the Catholic Church's first millennial saint on April 27, 2025. Born in London and raised in Milan, Carlo's wealthy parents were not particularly religious. Upon receiving his first communion at age seven, Carlo became a frequent communicant, making a point of praying before the tabernacle before or after every Mass. Considered a computer geek by some, Carlo was a gamer and computer programmer who loved the Eucharist. He spent four years creating a website dedicated to cataloging every reported Eucharistic miracle around the world, https://www.carloacutis.com/en/association/mostra-miracoli-eucaristici. Carlo was diagnosed with

leukemia as a teenager. Before his death in 2006, at the young age of 15, he offered his sufferings for Pope Benedict XVI and for the Church, saying: "I offer all of my suffering to the Lord for the pope and for the Church in order not to go to purgatory but to go straight to heaven."



JUBILEE YEAR 2025 APRIL CELEBRATIONS

On April 25-27, our Holy Father will be remembering in prayer and celebrating with teens. Every parish has teenage parishioners, and we recognize them for their importance to the life of the parish community. We give thanks, along with the Holy Father for our teens and their families during their gathering in Rome.

LENTEN REGULATIONS

- 1. Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- 2. Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- 3. On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
- 4. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.
- 5. Lent is the principal season of penance in the Christian year. All of the faithful are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial (in addition to following the Lenten regulations), serious prayer, and a performance of works of charity and mercy.







At the end of the National Eucharistic Congress last year, Bishop Cozzens announced there would be a National Eucharistic Pilgrimage from Indianapolis to Los Angeles in 2025.

Upon being asked, Bishop Hicks gratefully accepted the honor for the Diocese of Joliet to be the first Diocese on the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage St. Katharine Drexel Route.

The Diocese of Joliet will receive the Eucharist from the Pilgrims and Chaplains coming from a Mass in Indianapolis, IN on Sunday, May 18 and we will present the Eucharist to the Diocese of Peoria at St. Patrick Parish in Seneca, IL on Monday May 19.
