a humble servant of Your Word,

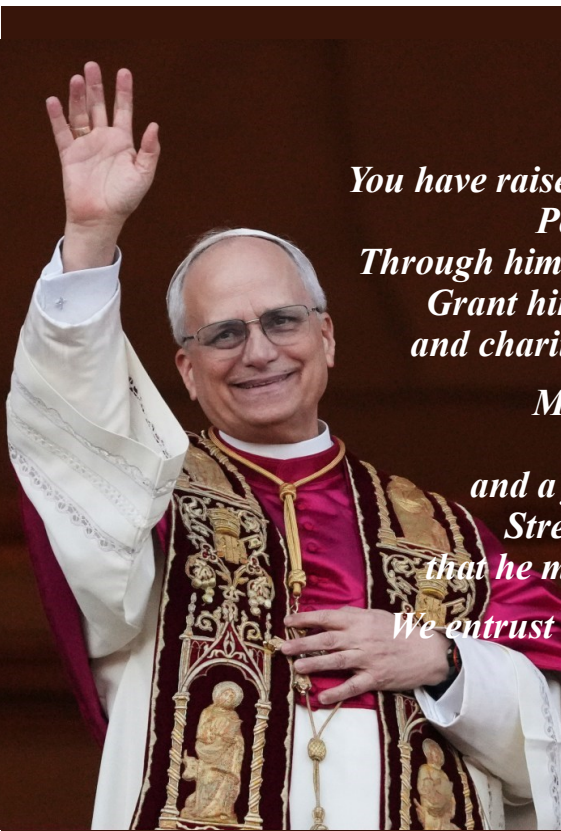

Corpus Christi's Confirmation program is two years long. Students generally begin in 7th grade but can begin later. The students use the "Chosen" book and videos from

Ascension Press. "Chosen" guides students through the Sacraments, the gifts and the fruits of the Holy Spirit and the responsibilities of being Confirmed.

All students are required to complete the following each year:

- **Attend fifteen Masses and complete a Mass Reflection form for each (submitted digitally).**
- **Complete ten service hours. Service hours can be community based, school based or available at Corpus Christi. A Service Project form must be completed for each.**
- **Attend a one day retreat held at Corpus Christi.**

Jubilee Year – Plenary Indulgences Explained

Pope Francis is inviting us to celebrate the Jubilee Year 2025 as Pilgrims of Hope. A jubilee year is a time to remember God's goodness, ask for His pardon, and praise Him for His mercy. As a Church, we normally celebrate jubilees every 25 years. Pope Francis has chosen the theme "Pilgrims of Hope" to remind us that we all make a pilgrim journey on earth with our hope set on heaven. This jubilee year began on December 24, 2024, when the Holy Father opened the Holy Doors at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome and continues through the celebration of the Epiphany on January 6, 2026.

What is a Plenary Indulgence?

A significant feature of the Jubilee year is the granting of a plenary indulgence – which is the complete removal of the effects of sin that remain in us even after we're forgiven. This will reduce the time in purgatory for yourself or for a deceased loved one.

What do I need to do?

The following conditions need to be met for a plenary indulgence:

- Have complete detachment from sin in your life
 - Pray for the intentions of Pope Francis
 - Make a Sacramental Confession and be in the state of grace
 - Receive Holy Communion
1. After these four conditions are met, a plenary indulgence can be obtained by visiting a pilgrimage site.
